



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

**INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AGENCY OF THE MINISTRY OF ECONOMY OF THE
REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA (AIPA)**

AND

KOREA INVENTION PROMOTION ASSOCIATION (KIPA)

Preamble

In furtherance of their mutual interests in the fields of invention and research, the Intellectual Property Agency of the Ministry of Economy of the Republic of Armenia (AIPA) and the Korea Invention Promotion Association (KIPA) hereby agree upon the following:

- For KIPA to share its intellectual property (IP) educational content with AIPA
- To develop the exchange of information, personnel exchanges and other relevant matters for the purpose of promoting an IP learning culture and fostering a close relationship between the two organizations

This collaboration will be developed between appropriate departments and units at the two organizations specified in agreements which are linked to this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

Article 1

KIPA shall provide AIPA with its IP educational content, including but not limited to its online courses, games and textbooks, in order to improve the standard of IP education in Armenia.

Article 2

KIPA shall help develop curricula incorporating its IP educational content for use in Armenia in order to maximize the effectiveness of the aforementioned content.

Article 3

The parties shall cooperate in the development of human resources in the field of IP, including teaching students, training teachers and sharing ideas and experiences in this sphere through such methods as seminars, workshops, roundtables and exhibitions.

Article 4

The parties agree to encourage the exchange of research, data, publications and materials related to IP.

Article 5

Each party agrees to invite representatives of the other party to participate in major conferences, symposiums and exhibitions of mutual interest.

Article 6

This MoU does not exclude the possibility of organizing other forms of exchange or expanding this MoU should both parties so desire.

Article 7

Each party will nominate its own representative and such representative will be responsible for all measures to be undertaken under this MoU.

Article 8

This MoU shall come into effect on the day of approval by both organizations with the duration of one year. Either organization may terminate this MoU provided that written notice of the intent is given at least six months prior to termination. Commitments already in progress shall be fulfilled.

Article 9

Amendments or changes to this MoU shall be made in writing and signed by the duly authorized representatives of the organizations.


